What is: BackSnack Packing ?



Imagine if you had to go to work on Monday morning and be productive if the last good meal you had was lunch on Friday.



Now imagine you're a school age child trying to concentrate and the only good, reliable, meals you get are the ones you get at school.

BackSnacks fill the gap on the weekends and provide nutritious food to kids in need.



ST. AIDAN'S EPISCOPAL CHURCH

What is: BackSnack Packing ?



BackSnacks are a program through Harvester's food bank to feed school aged children who are on school lunch assistance programs. We take canned goods and other food items and put them in a bag and tie the bag and box them up. These are then distributed to the schools by volunteer drivers Thursday morning. We serve 5 schools (about 40-50 kids at each school).

You can get involved by showing up on Wednesdays to help us bag the food items. Or, by showing up on Wednesdays to help us load the boxes of food into people's cars. Or, by signing up to be a regular or back up driver on Thursday mornings to take the food to the schools (contact david to sign up to be a driver).

How does BackSnack Packing help?

For the 2013-2014 school year the Harvester's BackSnack program provided nutritious food to 19,255 children every week. (2,150 in Johnson County)

Here in Olathe 435 children are homeless.

Participants had :

9% fewer tardies

10% fewer visits to the nurse

19% fewer visits to a counselor or social worker

Grades increased in 4 subjects studied from 12-22%

54% fewer discipline issues

What does St. Aidan's do with Johnson County Food Ministry at: Center of Grace?

The 4th Thursday of the month St. Aidan's cooks and serves a free meal at Center of Grace with the help of the Johnson County Food Ministry. You can get involved in one of three ways. You can volunteer to help cook the 4th Thursday afternoon, starting at 1PM, at center of Grace (520 S Harrison St., Olathe). Or, you can help serve the meal, starting at 5PM, at Center of Grace (520 S Harrison St., Olathe). If you can't help on the 4th Thursday, you can still support this ministry by bringing desserts to be distributed at the meal. Anytime the week before the 4th Thursday simply bring your desserts to St. Aidan's when the office is open (or during BackSnack packing, or the Sunday before) and we will make sure it gets taken to Center of Grace.
